Providing food, both fresh and non-perishable, plus cleaning, personal care, baby and household supplies to those in need, is our mission.

Individuals and Families

Individuals and families can shop once a month. Amounts are based on the size of the family and families.

Hours of Operation

Monday, Wednesday, ad Friday: Order pickups from 1:00 to 3:30 p.m.

Tuesday: Order pick-ups from 9:00 to 11:30 a.m.

Thursday, Saturday, Sunday: Closed New hours: Night Shop every 2nd and 4th Monday from 5 to 6:30 p.m..

This past year, 2024, we served over 25,000 individuals through the Dubuque Food Pantry. The need is even greater than ever as many working families are in need of our services. In 2022 we served 15,000 people. We will need even more supplies to serve all those new requests.

In June of 2024 we instituted a "Night Shop" on the second and forth Monday of each month. This is helping those who are working and not able to get to the DFP during the day. The "Night Shop" is from 5-6:30.

People In Need (P.I.N.)

During 2024 PIN celebrated its 42nd anniversary of serving people with emergency assistance needs in the Dubuque community. During the year, PIN provided assistance to 247 households. Total assistance dollars were \$77,660. The average assist per household was \$314.41. These figures document the tremendous need to provide basic human needs continue to grow in our community.

Our Dubuque community continues to be very generous. We are truly blessed with the support and donations of congregations, organizations, grantors and individuals to meet the increased need. *In 2024 PIN received \$82,719 in donations.*

The assistance provided by PIN is directed to families and individuals who are temporarily facing emergency health and safety circumstances and with nowhere else to turn for help.
